RESOLUTION NO 7 OF 2000

AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION OF THE GENERAL PUBLIC SERVICE SECTOR BARGAINING COUNCIL

The parties hereby resolve:

1. To amend clause 12 in the Constitution as follows:

"12. COMMITTEES AND CHAMBERS

- 12.1 The *Council* may establish committees or chambers in terms of section 30 (4) of the Act and such other conditions as it may determine, delegate any of its functions to any such committee or chamber in terms of section 55 of the Act.
- 12.2 Any agreement, decision or action of a committee or chamber shall be reported to the *Council* for consideration and may be ratified, set aside or varied by the *Council* unless the *Council* has specifically assigned the powers or functions to that committee or chamber.
- 12.3 The *Council*, by delegating any function, shall not divert any of its powers nor shall it be relieved of any function or duty that it may have delegated unless it expressly states the contrary.
- 12.4 Any committee or chamber established in terms of this clause shall consist of equal numbers of representatives of the *employer* and the *employee* organisations collectively, as well as the Chairperson.
- 12.5 Secretarial services shall be rendered to a committee or chamber as determined by the *Council*.

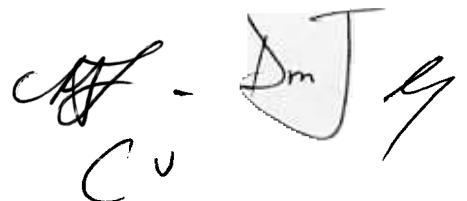
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12.6 General Public Service Sector

Chambers for National Departments and Provinces

- (a) The *Council* must, in every province referred to in section 103 of the Constitution and National Departments listed in schedule 1 of the *Public Service Act, 1994*, establish a departmental/provincial General Public Service Sectoral Chamber that will be the bargaining or consultative forum in that department/province
 - (i) A departmental/provincial General Public Service Sector Chamber established in terms of sub-clause (a) is not a juristic person.
 - (ii) A Departmental Provincial General Public Service Sector Chamber will function in a specific department/province and deal with matters referred to or delegated to it by the *Council*.

1. This agreement binds:
 - (a) the employer;
 - (a) the employees of the employer who are members of the trade union parties to this agreement; and
 - (a) the employees of the employer who are not members of any trade union parties to this agreement, but who fall within the registered scope of the sectoral *Council*.
- 2 This agreement shall come into effect from the date of signing.
- 3 If there is a dispute about the interpretation or application of this agreement, any party may refer the matter to the *Council* for resolution in terms of the dispute resolution procedure of the *Council*.
- 4 The *Council* will monitor the implementation of this agreement

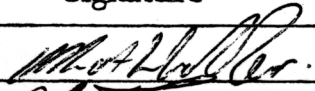
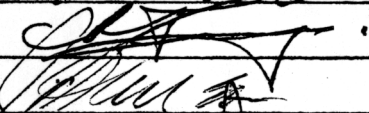
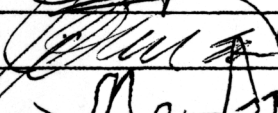
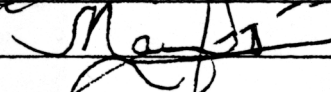
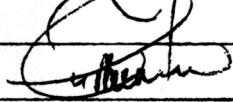
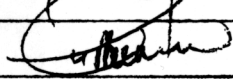
