

Agreement between the
GENERAL PUBLIC SERVICE SECTOR BARGAINING COUNCIL
Hereafter "(GPSSBC)"
And the
PUBLIC SERVICE CO-ORDINATING BARGAINING COUNCIL
Hereafter "(PSCBC)"

Purpose

1. To enter into an agreement between the GPSSBC and the PSCBC to deal with the payment of costs emanating from the administration of disputes by the GPSSBC on the application of PSCBC resolution 7 and 8 of 2002.

Scope

2. This agreement binds:
 - (a) the GPSSBC and
 - (b) The PSCBC.

Noting

3. The parties note:
 - 3.1 Paragraph 10.4 of PSCBC Resolution 7/2002 affords a party the opportunity to refer a dispute emanating from the said Resolution to the PSCBC or the relevant Sectoral Council.
 - 3.2 The PSCBC has taken a decision on the 29th January 2004 to refer disputes on application of PSCBC Resolution 7/2002 to the various Sectoral Councils.
 - 3.3 The PSCBC will fund the costs with regard to the adjudication of the said disputes.
 - 3.4 The GPSSBC signed agreement 2/2004 accepting the jurisdiction to deal with such cases.

Agreement

4. Parties agree to the following:
 - 4.1 From signing of the GPSSBC agreement 2/2004 the GPSSBC will administer, on behalf of the PSCBC, the following functions:



- (i) administration of disputes emanating from PSCBC resolution 7/2002 in as far as it is related to the application of the agreement,
 - (ii) administration to include but not limited to setting down of cases, allocating panellists, securing venues, travelling/ accommodation of panellists where applicable, securing of reports and/or awards on matters and the rescheduling of cases where applicable.
- administration of the payment of panellists' claims and dispute resolution costs, in line with relevant dispute resolution policies in so far as checking, sorting and authorisation of claims.
- Submission of such claims to PSCBC for payment.

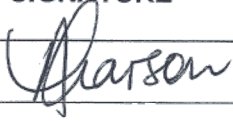
4.2 The PSCBC will be responsible for the processing and payment of such claims in line with the relevant dispute resolution policies.

Dispute Resolution

5. (a) Any dispute arising from the provisions of this agreement shall be referred to the Executive Committees of the GPSSBC and the PSCBC for resolution.
- (b) In the event of the dispute being unresolved, the GPSSBC shall, in consultation with the PSCBC, appoint an arbitrator to dispose of the matter.
