The GPSSBC hereby invites auditing companies who shows interest in providing the GPSSBC with external audit and other related services.

The successful auditing company will be expected to perform the following services: • External audit procedures as per International Standard on Auditing (ISAs) or any other applicable pronouncement, regulation and ethical standards of IRBA). • Fair presentation of the financial statements in accordance with the International Reporting Standards and the requirements of the Labour relations Act, 1995 (Act No. 66 of 1995). • Ability to assess the council ability to continue as a going concern and disclosing applicable matters related to going concern. • Any other audit related service that the GPSSBC may request from time to time.

Auditing companies are required to indicate any previous experience in performing audits for Bargaining Councils.

The following documents must be included in the proposal: • A company profile with all statutory information and a summative curriculum vitae (CV) of key personnel. • BBBEE rating and original Tax Clearance Certificate • Proof of registration with IRBA and letter of good standing from all applicable professional bodies. • A minimum of three references from current clients are required and a pricing schedule on estimated costs.

The Council may require short listed applicants to do a presentation on the proposal submitted. The appointment will be adjudicated in terms of pre-defined criteria. The criteria are obtainable from Council.
